Class requirements: Must have completed Puppy or Beginning Canine training class or equivalent. You must have instructor approval if your dog has had training elsewhere. Your dog must be friendly towards dogs and people!

Class Curriculum

Heel: walk by side, on and off leash

Recall: off leash

Distraction skills: focus and stay with distractions

Placement commands: go to your bed and lie down

Distance commands: sit and down commands at a distance

Required equipment: Leather or fabric collar, Gentle Leader/Haltie or Sensation Harness/Easy Walker and a leash.

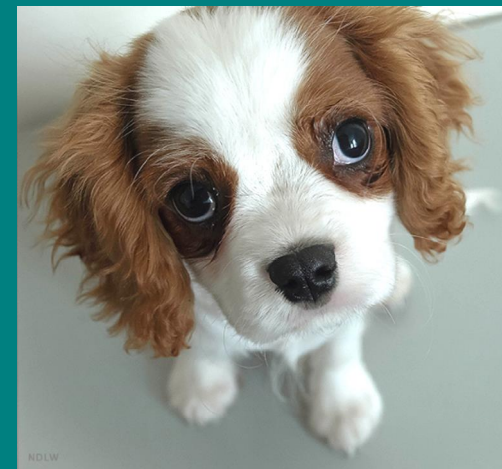

Puppy Party Classes are Important

Puppies begin learning at birth and their brains appear to be particularly responsive to learning and retaining experiences that are encountered during the first 6 to 16 weeks after birth. This means that new puppy owners, veterinarians, and behaviorists have a responsibility to assist in providing these learning/socialization experiences with other puppies/dogs, with children/adults, and with various environmental situations during this optimal period from birth to 16 weeks. To take full advantage of this early learning period, we recommend that puppy owners take them to puppy socialization classes, beginning at 6 to 9 weeks of age until they are 16 weeks old.

Puppy Party Class

Your Puppy will develop confidence, obedience, self-esteem and social skills while having fun learning in a safe place. Puppy Class is for pups 6 to 16 weeks old.

Class Schedule: Weekly until puppy is 16 weeks old. Classes held at Harden Ranch Veterinary Hospital starting at 7 pm.



Enrollment Fees: \$130 due prior to the first day of class. Class fees are non transferable and cancellation refunds are subject to a \$35.00 registration fee (see registration form for full details).

Puppy Vaccine Requirements: Puppies must have a minimum of one Distemper/Parvo immunization at least 7 days prior to the first day of class. Puppies should be kept up-to-date on boosters throughout the class. Vaccination records required 72 hrs prior to class.



Required equipment: Leather or fabric collar, leash and a small mat for your dog to sit on.

Class requirements: No previous classes are required.

Class Curriculum

Basic Obedience: Sit, down, stay, come, leash skills.

Manners: Jumping, don't touch, drop it, calm down

Social Skills: Proper playing skills on a leash, greeting other puppies.

Distraction Skills: Puppy learns to focus and work in a group environment.

Things Puppies Do: Chewing, nipping, house soiling and how to change this behavior positively.
